The Role

This role involves mechanical servicing, repairs and improvements to operating schemes, assisting with electrical installations, customer interaction and report writing, occasional general manual work, often outdoors, and in all weather conditions.

This role will report directly to the Hydropower Director and provides a fantastic opportunity to apply a range of engineering skills to optimising the operation of our hydroelectric plants.

The Candidate

The successful candidate will be someone who has 5+ years' experience in mechanical or electrical engineering. They will be interested in a demanding job requiring the efficient delivery of planned regular service and upgrade work, alongside urgent interventions for repairs. Flexible working hours will be required, along with frequent travel to various sites across the country.

You will have/be:

- Motivated to be involved in the renewables sector and enthusiastic/passionate about electrical and mechanical engineering;
- Strong interpersonal skills and a great team player;
- Ability to manage and effectively prioritise multiple projects and clients;
- Commitment to best practice, high quality work;
- Good knowledge of current HSE regulations and how these apply to the team;

- Willingness to travel to remote areas, often outside of traditional office hours (for which time off in lieu is provided);
